Partnership Updates

- Paul Sullivan added that the Carolinas AGC is aware of our partnerships and will spread the word to their membership.

General Discussion

- Ted Hendrix provided an update of the High Activity Counties for next year. Catawba, Franklin, and Henderson have been added; Chatham, Cumberland, and Davidson have been removed.
- As reported previously by Karen Bogner, Edgecombe and Carteret have been added as fatality counties for this year.
- Kevin Beauregard stated that we need to continue pushing forward with this SEP. He stated that construction fatalities are up for the calendar year (along with total fatalities). He asked if we need to look at our construction fatalities for any trends and stated that we could possibly issue Hazard Alerts for those items.
- Kevin Beauregard stated that FedOSHA has picked their tentative dates for the “stand downs” for next year. He stated that the months have been finalized for all events and the final days would be forthcoming. He stated that he would send the information to the committee.
- There was a brief discussion about the Construction Forums. Ted Hendrix stated that he had not yet spoken to Marcy Collyer about them, but that they were a success in 2019 and he was certain that we would hold them again next year. Paul Sullivan added that the Carolinas AGC is again on board for assisting with the forums.
- Ted Hendrix stated that the next meeting will be in January.
