Vinyl Chloride, 29 CFR 1910.1017

Final Rule, Corrections and Revisions

DISCUSSION:

On June 18, 1998, federal OSHA promulgated a final rule that corrected or eliminated provisions from various standards (63 FR 33449-33469). These changes were made to correct out of date, duplicative, unnecessary, or inconsistent standards.

One of the changes concerns the standard on vinyl chloride (Ref: 29 CFR 1910.1017). This rule corrects § 1910.1017 by deleting paragraphs (g)(5)(i) and (g)(5)(ii), because the operations discussed in these paragraphs are covered by the HAZWOPER standard, 29 CFR 1910.120.

ACTION:

The June 18, 1998, corrections and revisions (63 FR 33449-33469) were adopted verbatim with an effective date of October 8, 1998. The applicable portions of the referenced *Federal Register* ([pdf](#)) are attached.
