All fatalities will have an Accident/Event form and number. Fatalities can also occur due to a prior Referral or a Complaint of accident/injury, but once the employee is deceased it will then become a fatality with an Accident/Event form. When this happens, the Supervisor will be notified thru the Complaint Desk, they will then review and make the decision to open an Inspection/Investigation and assign.

The Supervisor will assign the CSHO to the Accident/Investigation form and update the Serious Fatal Log with CSHO assigned, Date Assigned and Inspection Planned. The Inspection number will be blank until the CSHO creates an Inspection and at that time will initiate the Investigation from the Accident/Event notification. The CSHO will also go to the Serious Fatal Log and enter the assigned Inspection number.






Why do I see these?
Other states that use the OE program send letters in some instances that NC does not use. These will be marked by the administrator as NA with a post date.



NOK- Next of Kin

NOK Letters are processed and mailed out by the administrative staff, but they are placed in the Attachments Section of the OE by the CSHO. The CSHO selects the correct letter to send and fills out any/all missing information “tags” concerning the NOK & deceased.



Once completed the CSHO “Imports” the letter into the Attachments and they will then **queue** to the admin staff that the letter is in the attachments and ready to send out.







It is the responsibility of the Occupational Safety and Health Division to investigate workplace accidents that result in the death of an employee. The purpose of our investigation is to determine the cause of the accident and whether there were any violations of occupational safety and health standards. This information could be vital in preventing a similar accident from occurring. The inspection process includes the following steps:

1. The inspection by a compliance safety and health officer begins with an on-site visit to the accident site and an opening conference with the employer. In the process of investigating the accident, various records will be reviewed including injury and illness records and training records, interviews will be conducted with employees and management officials, equipment will be examined and processes will be reviewed. After the investigation has been completed, a determination will be made as to whether any standards have been violated which could result in the issuance of citations. Citations can include monetary penalties.
2. Once the investigation is completed, you will receive a copy of the inspection results, including any citations issued to the employer. The inspection case file includes information relating to the inspection. Upon your written request, a copy of the case file can be shared with you once it is closed.
3. If the results of the investigation warrant criminal penalties, they will be pursued by the appropriate agency in accordance with North Carolina General Statute 95-139.

If you have information that might assist in the inspection process, or have questions or concerns about our policies or procedures, please feel free to contact me at 336-776-4420 or by email [EMAILADDRESS]. I am also available to meet with you to share any information that you may have that's relevant to the investigation. Also, if you would like to talk to someone else in the Department about the accident investigation process, please contact the North Carolina Department of Labor's





The OFIR is a report created by the PSIM's Division and can be found on the One Stop Shop. This report is sent out each month to Division Heads and the OE Administrator who must balance this report back to the OSHA Express Serious/Fatal UPA report. As you can see in this report there are four fatality inspections assigned and reported to the PSIM's division for the Federal year 2023 (10-01-2022/11-30-2022) which begins October 1st of each year.

To review this report in the OE the administrator runs the Accidents-Serious/Fatal(UPA) Tracking. From this report using the same date range and the OFIR report, you can see that in the OE it is showing 7 fatality inspections vs the 5 on the OFIR. The administrator will review each inspection on the S/F report to ensure that it is a Fatality with the Scope of Partial or under certain approved instances Comprehensive.



Here is what was found on the first inspection not on the OFIR. You will see that (1) the Scope of the inspection is "No Inspection" (2) the Serious Fatal Log still references this inspection as Assigned, Date Assigned and Inspection Planned as Yes. (3) The information on the Serious Fatal Log is incorrect and has not been updated. Once the fatality inspection has been updated to a No Inspection the CSHO should go into the Serious Fatal Log and remove the (1) Inspection number (2) Inspection Planned (NO) (3) CSHO Assigned should be right clicked out and Date Assigned should be right clicked out. Save your modifications. This will remove it from the Serious Fatal UPA report, Inspection Summary Report and the SAMM (OIS) report. This in essence will clear up 3 reports in the system that are incorrect due to the Serious Fatal Log not being updated correctly.
