

Subject: Change to the Bureau Of Compliance Operations Manual  
Addition of Chapter XIV, Safety and Health Programs and  
Committees

- A. Purpose.  
The OPN transmits new Chapter XIV to the Operations Manual with an effective date of **November 15, 1993.**
- B. Action.  
New Chapter XIV should be added to the Operations Manual. Policies in this Chapter should be used to enforce the Safety and Health Programs and Committees Act.
- C. Change Explanation.  
The Safety and Health Programs and Committees Act was passed by the 1992 Session of the North Carolina General Assembly with the intent of reducing hazards in the workplace. The North Carolina Division of Occupational Safety and Health was given the responsibility for enforcing this new law. This law is not a part of the Occupational Safety and Health Act, but rather an separate Act to address the safety and health of North Carolina citizens. This law affects those employers with an experience rate modifier of 1.5 or greater.
